

ANNUAL ALUMNI SERVICE AWARD

ELIGIBILITY

- Previous student participant in a school chapter
- At least 5 years post-graduation from high school
- Contributing to society through public service, the workforce, or volunteering
- Available to attend the award presentation at the Saluting Stories of Service Gala
- Current Staff and Board Directors who are alumni are not eligible

CRITERIA

- Submissions will be reviewed by the Gala committee and Board of Directors with the score based on:
 - Ability to describe positive impact from veterans, oral history, and/or program activities
 - Demonstration of retained lessons, skills, traits, and/or abilities
 - o Continued engagement in civic, community, or leadership activities
- Finalists will be contacted with any questions.
- Notification of selection will be made to all applicants

AWARD

- Complimentary attendance for the recipient and a guest at the Saluting Stories of Service Gala
- Recognition Award to be presented at the gala
- Profile in gala materials, social media outlets, and Spring newsletter

NOMINATION - nomination to info@imprintsofhonor.org

- Nominate one of your fellow alumni. Teachers, nominate one of your former students.
- In 250 words or less, briefly describe why you are nominating this person for the Alumni Service Award. Keep in mind the award criteria: ability to describe positive impact from veterans, oral history, and/or program activities; demonstration of retained lessons, skills, traits, and/or abilities; and continued engagement in civic, community, or leadership activities.
- Imprints of Honor will keep applications from previous year submissions.
- Nominations are due September 1
